

# Exhibition Jury Application Jury held as needed

Artists wishing to apply to host a solo or group exhibition for a period of one month should apply for the exhibition jury. Artists already juried in for gallery retail may apply, as may Guild members who are not currently represented in the gallery. Exhibition submissions will be accepted throughout the year – there are no dates or deadlines. The Exhibitions Committee will convene when necessary in order to assess the applications. Exhibitions will be programmed for the following year and the year after – we schedule two years ahead. The submission package must be delivered to the Gallery of BC Ceramics.

#### **Submissions must include:**

- 1. You must be a PGBC member in good standing. If you are a new member or your membership has lapsed please sign up or renew your membership via paypal online: www.bcpotters.com/amember/signup.php
- 2. Signed Gallery Policy: www.bcpotters.com/Guild/forms/Gallery policy
- 3. **\$15 jury fee** payable to Gallery of BC Ceramics or PGBC. (jury fee is non-refundable.)
- 4. Artist Statement and Biography. Include your website if you have one.
- 5. A complete verbal description of the intention of your exhibition. Your **Theme, Concept and Premise** must be clearly defined.
- 6. If the work already exists, submit at least three photo images of pieces you propose for the exhibition. Otherwise, include sketches of proposed pieces and photo images of existing work that closely resembles your intended exhibition pieces.

Your submission is required to prove to the jury that your concept is solid and well conceived, that the work is reflective of the concept, and that prototypes are in process.

7. State your top three preferred months to have your exhibition, and stipulate the year in which you wish to host your exhibition – we program two years ahead. Please note that exhibition sales expectations differ for each month –exhibitions scheduled for the summer months have a far higher sales expectation. At the discretion of the members of the jury, summer months may remain closed to the exhibition program.

### No exhibitions will be hosted in December.

A member of the exhibition jury will contact you directly if more information is required, or if the jury needs to see physical pieces of your work.

The jury will not provide feedback to applicants, but all applicants will be notified of the outcome within two weeks of the jury meeting. Incomplete or unprofessional applications will be disregarded – professional presentation is mandatory.
